## Optional Flexible Year Program Requirements

Pawnee Junior High School  
(6<sup>th</sup> -8<sup>th</sup> grades)

Students who meet the following criteria will be eligible for the 170-day school calendar. All other students will be required to attend 180 days:

1. Pass all TAKS tests administered during the prior school year.
2. Score 5 questions above the state standard on most recent benchmark test administered.
3. Pass all courses taken with a grade of 75 or above – (Based on each six-weeks grade).
4. No more than 10 absences with a maximum of 3 unexcused absences during the school year.
5. No discipline referral or incident within the school year that results in an assignment to in-school suspension (ISS).
6. No DAEP/JJAEP placement.

Pawnee Elementary School  
(4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> grades)

1. Pass all TAKS tests administered during the prior school year.
2. Score 5 questions above the state standard on most recent benchmark test administered.
3. Pass all courses taken with a grade of 75 or above – (Based on each six-weeks grade).
4. No more than 10 absences with a maximum of 3 unexcused absences during the school year.
5. No discipline referral or incident within the school year that results in an assignment to in-school suspension (ISS).
6. No DAEP placement.

Pawnee Elementary School  
(3<sup>rd</sup> grade)

1. Score 90% on most recent benchmark test administered.
2. Pass all courses taken with a grade of 75 or above – (Based on each six-weeks grade).
3. No more than 10 absences with a maximum of 3 unexcused absences during the school year.
4. No discipline referral or incident within the school year that results in an assignment to in-school suspension (ISS).
5. No DAEP placement.

Parents may “opt” for their child to attend 180 days even if they are eligible for the 170 days.
